



Title: Streetlight and Walkway Banner Advertising

Streetlight and walkway banner advertising is for the primary purpose of promoting significant tourist or community events, community awareness programs or conferences being held at the Darwin Convention Centre.

Approval is at the discretion of the Darwin Waterfront Corporation.

Persons and organisations may apply in writing to the Darwin Waterfront Corporation for the placement of banners on the:

1. Banner poles within the Darwin Waterfront Precinct
2. Kitchener Drive pedestrian footbridge
3. Hughes Avenue pedestrian footbridge

The requesting person/organisation will be required to secure the services of an approved contractor to carry out the works at a cost to the requesting person/organisation.

The Darwin Waterfront Corporation does not charge a booking fee.

The works will need to be carried about between Monday and Friday, before 9am or after 6.30pm.

The Darwin Waterfront Corporation will require a copy of the contactors relevant insurance papers.

As the roads are within a road reserve the requesting person/organisation will need to apply for a permit to work within a road reserve. The cost of the permit is \$27.50.

Any change to traffic conditions as part of the banner installation/dismantling will need the approval of the Darwin Waterfront Corporation prior to works being carried out and the requesting person/organisation will need to place an advertisement in the NT News advising the public of the changed road conditions.

Any damage to infrastructure as a result of the banner installation, dismantling or display will be at a cost to the requesting person/organisation.

Maximum timeframe for banners to be displayed is at the Corporation's discretion.
